

Green Roof Shares

Trinity Church installed a green, vegetated roof over the Education Wing in May 2009. This project, begun as part of the Imagine Trinity project, will provide for longer roof life, lower utility costs, and improved storm water management. Most importantly, it enables us to be better stewards of God's Creation. We can witness right here at Trinity Church.

The green roof which we now have is correcting the roof design and leak problems ever since the Education Wing was built in 1955. This new roof is expected to last until 2070 or beyond, with proper vigilance. The design was by a U.S. expert, Roofscapes of Philadelphia, and the installation was by JIG of Philadelphia. We have a ten year system warranty which is supplemented by a two-year maintenance contract for this \$57,000 project. To learn more, please visit our website:
